**Bob and Mike Bryan – The Best Doubles Players of All Time – Return
to Vero Beach for Mardy’s Tennis & Jake’s Music Fest
The World No. 1 Bryan Brothers Join Forces with ATP Professionals Mardy Fish and
Sam Querrey and RCA Nashville Recording Artists Jake Owen and Chris Young
Proceeds to Benefit the Mardy Fish Foundation and Jake Owen Foundation**

Vero Beach, Fla. – **Bob Bryan and Mike Bryan – the Bryan Brothers** – are the top-ranked doubles team in the world and the most successful team in the history of the sport. On **December 9, 2011**, they will join Vero Beach native **Mardy Fish**, the top ranked American singles player, and ATP professional **Sam Querrey** in the **Tennis Exhibition**, one of the highlights of the annual benefit **Mardy’s Tennis & Jake’s Music Fest**. The exhibition will begin with a singles match of **Fish vs. Querrey**, followed by a doubles match of **Fish and Querrey vs. The Bryan Brothers**.

Twin brothers Bob and Mike Bryan captured six ATP World Tour doubles titles in 2011 to bring their career total to 73 – the most doubles team in tennis history. Following a successful 2011 campaign that included victories at the Australian Open and Wimbledon, the Bryan Brothers have won 11 career Grand Slam titles. The Bryans’ other 2011 wins came in Houston, Monte Carlo, Madrid and London. They are currently ranked No. 1 in the world, and are poised to wrap up 2011 with the top ranking on the ATP World Tour for the fifth time in the last six years. The Bryans – southpaw Bob and right-handed Mike – also improved their Davis Cup record to an impressive 18-2 with victories against Chile and Spain. The Bryan Brothers will lend their support to Mardy’s Tennis & Jake’s Music Fest for the third time. The duo participated in the inaugural event in 2006, and returned in 2010 to battle Fish and Ivan Lendl in the Tennis Exhibition.

“I am so happy to have Bob and Mike return to Vero Beach to support Mardy’s Tennis & Jake’s Music Fest,” says Fish, “Their trademark brand of doubles tennis was a highlight of the event in 2006 and again in 2010. I have played in the Bryan Brothers’ charity event in the past, and we are excited to continue to work together to help youth in need.”

The Mardy Fish Foundation, established in 2006, mission is to provide children access to after school exercise, nutritional and enrichment programs in a safe environment to prepare them for healthy, productive and successful lives so they can achieve their dreams. Founded in 2010, the Jake Owen Foundation was created to offer its support on a national level to children battling cancer and other childhood diseases while also lending its support to the Mardy Fish Foundation and its mission to assist youth in Fish and Owen’s hometown area of Indian River County, FL.

Mardy Fish, the top ranked American tennis player, had a career-best season in 2011. In August, Fish won the US Open Series by defeating Richard Gasquet in the fourth round of the Western & Southern Open in Cincinnati. Fish had a truly outstanding summer on the Series, winning the Atlanta Tennis Championships for the second consecutive year, reaching the finals at the Farmers Classic in Los Angeles and Rogers Cup in

Montreal, and defeating world No. 2 Rafael Nadal for the first time in his career to reach the semifinals in Cincinnati. Fish also reached the semifinals in Key Biscayne, third round at the French Open, quarterfinals at Wimbledon, and fourth round at the US Open.

Meanwhile, the success of **Jake Owen's** third studio album, *Barefoot Blue Jean Night*, continues to grow. The first single, "Barefoot Blue Jean Night," was certified **Platinum** by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) on September 21. Both the single and the album have topped the *Billboard* charts for country, with the album reaching No. 6 on the *Billboard Hot 200* for all genres. Earlier in the year, "Eight Second Ride" became the first **Gold** certified single of Owen's career. Owen will be joined by Gold certified recording artist **Chris Young** for the **Concert** at 6500-seat Holman Stadium.

In June, Fish and Owen announced that **Mardy's Tennis & Jake's Music Fest** will return to **Vero Beach at Grand Harbor Golf & Beach Club**, Official Host Sponsor of event, and **Holman Stadium formerly "Dodgertown" at Vero Beach Sports Village** on **December 9-10, 2011**.

Supporters of Fish, Owen, Querrey, the Bryan Brothers and Young will have the opportunity to see these stars firsthand as they team up to raise funds for the **Mardy Fish Foundation** and the **Jake Owen Foundation** at the sixth annual Mardy's Tennis & Jake's Music Fest. Fish and Owen are proud to present an exciting two-day event featuring a **Kids' Tennis Clinic, Reception with Live and Silent Auction** and Tennis Exhibition featuring Mardy Fish, Sam Querrey and the Bryan Brothers on Friday, December 9th. A Concert with Jake Owen and Chris Young will be held on Saturday, December 10th at 7:00 p.m.

Vero Beach native Mardy Fish is currently ranked No. 8 on the ATP World Tour and has been ranked as high as No. 7 in the world. Over the course of his career he has won six singles titles and eight doubles titles while defeating players such as Roger Federer, Rafael Nadal, Andy Roddick, Andy Murray and in doubles Novak Djokovic. Fish was a Silver Medalist at the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens. In addition to representing his country at the Olympics, Fish has been an important member of the U.S. Davis Cup team during the past decade. Jake Owen, also a Vero Beach native, is a Grammy, CMA, ACM and CMT award-nominated artist who was named the 2009 Top New Male Vocalist by the Academy of Country Music. Sam Querrey began playing tennis at the age of four when he was introduced to the game by his parents Mike and Chris Querrey. After his breakout year in 2008, Sam followed up in 2009 by advancing to the final in Auckland before the Australian Open in January. Later in the season, he reached the final of three consecutive tournaments. He improved to being ranked #26 on the ATP World Singles Rankings, which made him the youngest ranked player in the top 50. After an accident cut his season short in 2009, Sam bounced back in 2010, winning his third career title in Memphis. He defeated John Isner in the finals, and the two then proceeded to win the doubles title. Sam was also selected to represent the US in Davis Cup action for the second time in his young career. Currently, Sam resides in Santa Monica, near where he grew up in Thousand Oaks with many of his friends who are now a part of his widely known Samurai Club.
